This workshop is designed to provide educational professionals with an understanding of and sensitivity to diverse considerations that may enhance educational outcomes for families and students from different cultural, linguistic, and SES backgrounds.

English is MariLuz's second language. She was retained a year and placed in special education services in second grade due to cultural differences and

typical second language learner characteristics that were confused for a disability. After protesting to be removed from special education in fifth grade, she was re-tested out of service and went on to graduate high school a year early with a regents endorsed diploma and the highest English regents score of her class. She quickly entered the education field with hopes to prevent similar situations.
